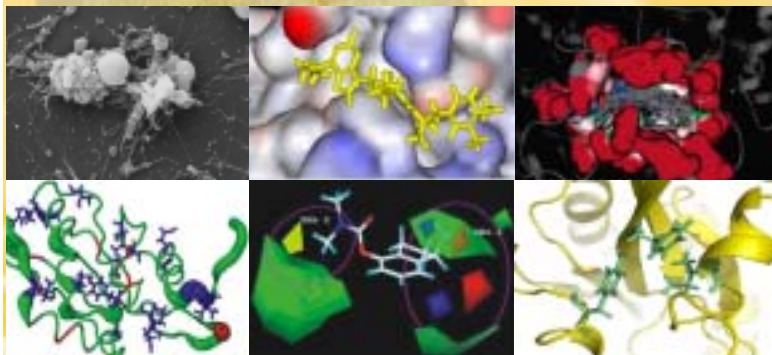

The 4th International symposium entitled "Current Trends in Drug Discovery Research" (CTDDR-2010) is being organized in the spirit of the 1st, 2nd & 3rd CTDDRs (2001, 2004 & 2007) symposia from 17th to 21st February 2010. The symposium will focus on the innovative approaches to drug discovery & development for infectious & tropical diseases (malaria, filaria, leishmania, HIV, tuberculosis), aging, genetic, metabolic & endocrine disorders (neurodegenerative, diabetes, obesity, CNS & CVS related disorders) and reproductive disorders (osteoporosis). The deliberations shall contain the cocktail of computational endeavors, innovative drug discovery approaches and indepth analysis of Structure Activity Relationships (SAR), new drug targets and state of art techniques for syntheses of organic molecules. A preliminary classification of sub-areas for discussions is as follows:

- Cellular and molecular signaling.
- Virtual library design and screening.
- Systems biology.
- Drugs from nature /bioimaging & bioprospecting.
- Molecular approaches to disease therapy.
- Validated therapeutic targets.
- Drug design, synthesis, QSAR, CADD & CAMM.
- Novel approaches to drug discovery.
- Pharmacokinetics/pharmaceutical sciences.
- Translational research.
- Informatics in drug discovery.
- Preclinical/clinical trials.
- Ethics, regulation & governance.
